*Lack of 1G involvement upfront (navgating internal processes) * Inconsistency: collaborating areales more capacity * Use/difference in use of (IAR)s * Can't properly identify the right stakeholders to work with * Fear : need for balance + connection to "why"/purpose for sharing * Political + Cultural appritte: cannon undestanding / willingness to challenge + confidence * Digital skills : collective knowledge ; cf. building wider understanding in throams way as finance * Diversity: switching from being risk-averse in coses of breaches to governing the right use / sharing of data * Culture: busy; easier to say no *Project + Service Leads need to have 1G understanding (DIY culture: Sense of automorship) * Get better at articulating use of data to the public * Legacy thinking
